

ORDER OF

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.63 (9) and 101.73 (12), Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby creates and adopts rules of Wis. Adm. Code Chapter Ind 69, Fee Schedule.

The rules attached hereto shall become effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats. Section Ind 69.20 is created to read:

Ind 69.20 CERTIFICATION OF UNIFORM DWELLING CODE INSPECTORS AND INDEPENDENT INSPECTION AGENCIES. All applicants for certification as a certified inspector or independent inspection agency shall submit, with the application form, fees in accordance with the following:

(1) <u>Certified inspectors</u>. Persons applying for initial certification or recertification as a certified inspector shall submit fees for each category in which they plan to conduct inspections in accordance with the following schedule:

First category.			•								\$20.00
Second category									•		\$5.00
Third category.										٠	\$5.00
Fourth category											\$5.00

- (a) Examinations for certification. Upon determination of eligibility for the examination for certification, fees shall be assessed and collected in accordance with the following schedule:
- (b) Educational and training seminars. Fees will be assessed on a per seminar basis for educational and training programs sponsored by the department.
- (2) <u>Independent inspection agencies</u>. Fees for the initial certification or recertification of independent inspection agencies shall be assessed annually at the cost of \$100.
