

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Superintendent of Public Instruction by Section 121.05, Wisconsin Statutes, the state of Wisconsin, Department of Public Instruction, hereby adopts rules as follows:

That PI 14 be created to read:

PI 14 SCHOOL FINANCE

14.01 Official Enrollment. (1) A resident pupil may be included in the official enrollments of the schools of a district as of the date specified in s. 121.05(1)(a), Stats., only if:

(a) He or she is in attendance on that date; or

(b) He or she is absent on that date but has attended at least one day during the current school year prior to that date and attends at least one day after that date; or

(c) In the event a pupil has been absent all days during the current school year prior to and on that date, an application has been made for formal homebound instruction as of that date and documentation exists to support this application.

(2) If a pupil who is eligible to be included in the official enrollment under (1)(b) of this section returns following the filing of the Fall Budget Report, an amended report shall be filed.
