

## ORDER ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Medical Examining Board by Sections 15.08(5), 227.08 and 448.40, Wis.Stats., the board hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section Med. 1.06(4) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

Oral examinations of each applicant are conducted by one or more physician members of the board. The purpose of the oral exams is to test the applicant's knowledge of the practical application of medical principles and techniques of diagnosis and treatment, judgment and professional character and are scored pass or fail. Any applicant who fails the initial oral examination shall be examined by the board which shall then make the final decision as to pass or fail.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
