



ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 144.31, 144.36, 144.38 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 154.13 (3) (c) 2. and 4. are amended to read:

- 2. No owner or operator of a gasoline dispersing facility and no owner of a gasoline storage tank at such a facility shall transfer or cause or allow the transfer of gasoline from any delivery vessel into any stationary storage tank not excluded under subd. (3)(c)1. unless the storage tank is equipped with a submerged fill pipe and the vapors displaced from it by filling are processed by a vapor control system in accordance with subd. (3)(c)3.
- 4. The operator of a delivery vessel shall not commence transfer of gasoline to any gasoline dispensing facility equipped with a vapor balance system pursuant to subd. (3)(c)3.a. without first properly connecting the vapor return line. The delivery vessel shall be designed, maintained and operated to be vapor tight at all times that it is vapor-laden.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 28, 1979.


