

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, TRADE & CONSUMER PROTECTION ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, by sections 97.07(1), 97.20(2), 97.24, and 97.52, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section Ag 30.08(3) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed and recreated to read:

Ag 30.08(3) TOILETS. (a) Every dairy farm shall have one or more sanitary toilets conveniently located.

- (b) Toilets shall be constructed and maintained in a sanitary manner so that waste does not pollute the ground surface or contaminate any water supply.
- (c) Toilets in the residence, other farm buildings or otherwise conveniently located shall meet the requirements of par. (a).

The rules herein contained shall take effect as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
