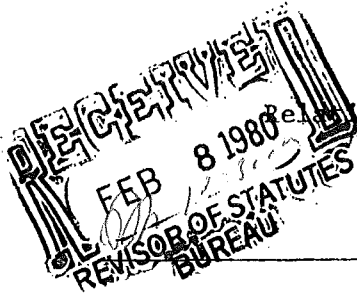

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

The purpose of the rule changes is to eliminate commercial bail bond insurance as a line or class of insurance within the Commissioner's regulatory power except surety insurance for traffic arrest bonds under s. 345.61. These changes will bring the existing administrative rules in compliance with s. 969.12 as amended by Chapter 34, Laws of 1979 to limit a surety to a natural person.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby repeals and amends:

Section Ins 3.22 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.


Section Ins 6.75 (2) (f) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Ins 6.75 (2) (f) Fidelity insurance--insurance against loss arising out of the acts or defaults of persons in positions of trust, excluding commercial bail bond insurance except as a surety under s. 345.61, Stats.

Section Ins 6.75 (2) (g) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Ins 6.75 (2) (g) Surety insurance--payment for loss arising out of failure to perform contracts or obligations, excluding commercial bail bond insurance except as a surety under s. 345.61, Stats.
