ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Repealing Rules

Relating to rules concerning the apprentice program.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

The purpose of this rule is to replace the apprentice program with a procedure so that an applicant can retest as often as he desires without restriction.

Pursuant to the Authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby repeals and renumbers rules interpreting s. 628.09, Stats., as follows:

Section Ins 6.59 (6) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section Ins 6.59 (9) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section Ins 6.60 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Subsections (7), (8), and (10) of section Ins 6.59 are renumbered to be subsections (6), (7), and (8), respectively.

SUMMARY OF FISCAL EFFECT

This proposal will result in the agency saving the cost of administering the apprentice program estimated at \$2,900.00 and in additional revenues estimated at \$4,000.00.
