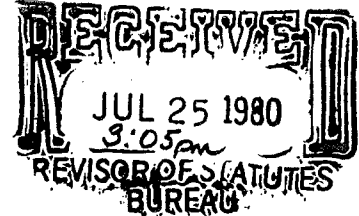

AMENDING RULES

 IN THE MATTER of amending section .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Section NR 112.15(8)(b)1.c., Wisconsin Administrative Code, is being amended to correct a typographical error contained in the previous order amending section NR 112.15(8)(b), Wis. Adm. Code, permitting the injection of pesticides into the well discharge pipe of an irrigation system. The sentence "Injection of pesticides into the well pump discharge line is prohibited" was inadvertently allowed to remain in the rule rather than being deleted as is necessary for the implementation of the intended amendment.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 162.01, 162.03(1)(e) and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting sections 144.025(2)(c) and 144.025(2)(e), and 162.01, Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 112.15 (8) (b) 1.c. is amended to read:

c. Injection of fertilizer into the well pump discharge pipe is acceptable, providing it is done with an approved positive displacement type of chemical feed pump at a point following a barometric pipe loop extending at least 30 feet above the highest part of the irrigation system; or a reduced pressure backflow preventer made to and meeting AWWA C506-78 or ASSE 1013 standards; or an underwriters laboratories (UL) approved check valve and preferably a

double UL check valve installed in the well pump discharge pipe at the well site. The chemical feed pump shall be shut off at least 5 minutes prior to shutting off of the well pump so as to purge the chemical from the water system. ~~Injection of pesticides into the well pump discharge line is prohibited.~~


The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 28, 1979.

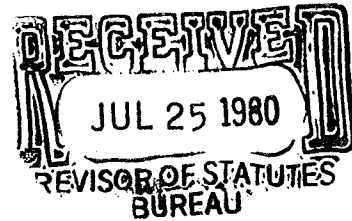




Dear Mr. Prestegard:
