

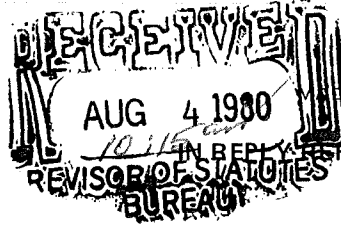

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

.....
 IN THE MATTER of amending NR 20.03(1)(f)1.a. .
 and creating NR 20.04(7)(e) of the Wisconsin .
 Administrative Code pertaining to a fishing . F-12-80
 for fun section on Trout Creek, Iowa County .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

A fertilizer spill into Trout Creek has resulted in a fish kill. Live trout were removed from a portion of the stream to curtail additional mortality. The department anticipates restocking the stream the week of April 20, 1980. By emergency order the stream has been closed to fishing. After it has been determined the fish are not in a stress condition, a catch and release season is recommended for this portion of the stream until the fishing has recovered. Fishing would be limited to the use of artificial lures and flies.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09, 29.174 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules interpreting sections 23.09 and 29.174, Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 20.03 (1) (f) 1.a. is amended to read:

Kinds of Fish	Open Season (both dates inclusive)	Daily Bag Limit	Minimum Length (inches)
a. Columbia, Grant, Iowa, Lafayette, Richland and Sauk county waters, including lakes (ponds) except that portion of Trout creek beginning in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, sec. 5, T6N, R5E downstream to the earthen dam located on section lines 19 and 30, T7N, R5E, Iowa county, which shall have a fishing for fun open season subject to section NR 20.04(7)(e).	January 1 to September 30	5 in aggregate	6

SECTION 2 - Section NR 20.04 (7) (e) is created to read:

(e) Trout creek - In, on or along that part of Trout creek, Iowa county from and including the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, sec. 5, T6N, R5E at the Birch lake outlet downstream to the earthen dam on section lines 19 and 30, T7N, R5E shall be open for catch and release trout fishing subject to par. (c).

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on March 27, 1980.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication as provided in section 227.026(1) intro., Wisconsin Statutes.
