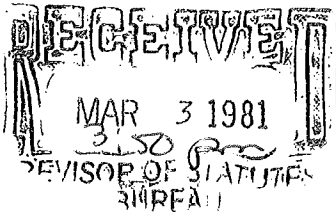



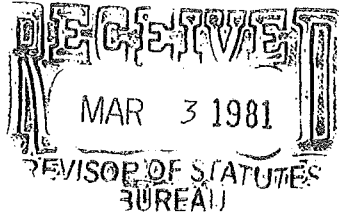
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

**ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE
REPEALING AND RENUMBERING A RULE**

Relating to certification of compliance for insurer's advertising files.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Since this rule has been in existence, the requirement that a certification of compliance for advertising files has generated a great deal of paper. The benefits deriving from these filings do not justify the cost of their handling and filing.


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wis. Stats., the Commissioner hereby repeals and renumbers a rule interpreting sections 628.34 and 601.01 (3), Wis. Stats., as follows:

Section Ins 3.27 (29) is repealed.

Sections Ins 3.27 (30), (31) and (32) are renumbered Ins 3.27 (29), (30) and (31).

As provided in s. 227.026 (1), (intro.), this rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following its publication.
