ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Amending a Rule

Relating to fees for health care providers participating in the Patients Compensation Fund.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

The purpose of these amendments is to implement and interpret the provisions of section 655.27 (3), Stats., relating to fees to be paid by health care providers for participation in the Patients Compensation Fund. The rule was originally adopted to provide fees to be effective from July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981. The purpose of these amendments is to revise the rule to provide for fees to be effective from July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982, to reflect the actuarial-underwriting experience by the Fund.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3) and 655.27 (3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby amends a rule implementing and interpreting section 655.27, Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:
