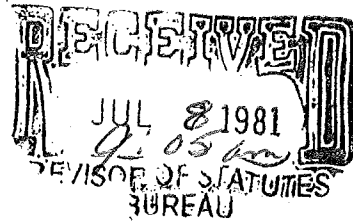

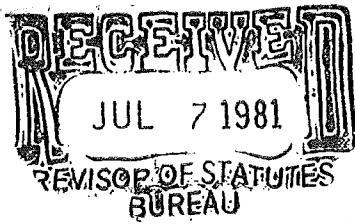

ORDER OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES
REPEALING AND ADOPTING RULES

Relating to rules concerning the Wisconsin Drug Formulary.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Health and Social Services

The repeal of Chapter H27 and creation of Chapter HSS 127 is designed to increase the number of drugs on the Wisconsin Drug Formulary. Chapter 168, Laws of 1975, revised the state pharmacy statutes by amending the drug anti-substitution law. These changes permitted the pharmacist to select a drug product equivalent from a list created by the Department of Health and Social Services, and to use this product in place of a brand name product indicated on the prescription. This list (Wisconsin Drug Formulary) is created with the advice of the Drug Quality Council appointed by the Governor. The first list was promulgated in October of 1976 and has been revised five times since then. This revision seeks to increase the scope and utilization of the formulary by increasing the number of drugs available for substitution. These additions will also increase the savings realized by individual and institutional purchasers of pharmaceuticals.

The drugs and drug products being added to the formulary have been recommended for inclusion by the Drug Quality Council, following several public meetings at which representatives of manufacturers were invited to voice their comments. The Council has reviewed the comparative data and manufacturing information and has selected those drug products which may be safely interchanged.

In addition to increasing the number of drugs on the formulary, these rules change the listed product costs and average cost lines to reflect changes in acquisition costs. The rules are also changed to indicate approval of manufacturers rather than distributors. Since a manufacturer may supply 40-50 distributors with the same product, it becomes cumbersome to attempt to include all approved distributors. The inclusion of some distributors is to show price variations and to establish the average cost line. The distributors selected were those which are readily available in Wisconsin.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services by sections 140.05(3) and 140.90, Wis. Stats., the Department of Health and Social Services repeals and adopts rules interpreting sections 140.90 and 450.075, Wis. Stats., as follows:

Section 1. Chapter H27 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section 2. Chapter HSS127 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is adopted to read:

HSS 127.01 STATUTORY AUTHORITY. The following rules implement ss. 140.90 and 450.075, Stats., which require the department of health and social services to create, implement, and administer the Wisconsin drug formulary.

HSS 127.02 DEFINITIONS. (1) "Average cost" means a unit cost determined by the department to be the mean acquisition cost of the drug product equivalents.

(2) "Department" means the department of health and social services.

(3) "Drug product" means a specific drug in a specific dosage form from a known source of manufacture, whether by brand name or generic name.

(4) "Drug product equivalent" means a drug product listed in the formulary as being chemically identical and therapeutically equivalent to a brand name or reference drug product.

(5) "Drug product substitution" means the process by which a pharmacist dispenses a drug product other than the product prescribed by a practitioner.

(6) "Formulary" means this chapter.

(7) "Unit" means the most common dosage form of a listed drug product. For oral solid forms the unit is a single capsule or tablet; for other forms the unit is listed.

HSS 127.025 USE OF DRUG PRODUCT EQUIVALENTS IN FILLING PRESCRIPTIONS.

For the purposes of s.450.075 Stats., only those drug products listed in the drug formulary under the heading of approved manufacturers are considered to be drug product equivalents, and any substitution under this section shall be performed with a drug product equivalent from an approved manufacturer.

NOTE: Approved manufacturers include all names under which the product is manufactured by that facility, i.e., approval of Purepac also includes its Kalipharm and Rondex labels, and approval of Drummer also includes the Lemmon Co. label.

HSS 127.03 POSTING. An unaltered copy of the most recent volume of the formulary, as published by the department, shall be conspicuously posted and available for consumer review wherever prescription drugs are sold. A sign printed and distributed by the department informing the consumer of the formulary and of the prescription filling options available for drugs listed in the formulary shall be posted in such a manner that it is easily noticed and can be easily read by a reasonable person presenting a prescription order to the pharmacist or pharmacist's agent for filling.

HSS 127.04 NOTIFICATION. If the prescription order is written for a specific drug product listed in the formulary, the pharmacist or an agent of the pharmacist shall inform the consumer that the prescribed drug product is listed in the formulary and that a drug product equivalent may be dispensed. This notification shall be made by means of an oral or written statement to the consumer at the time the prescription order is presented for filling; or at the time of delivery of the completed medication if the delivery occurs off the pharmacy premises.



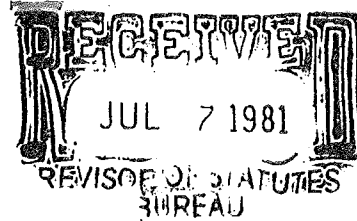
