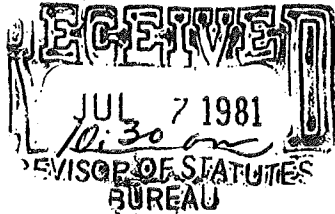

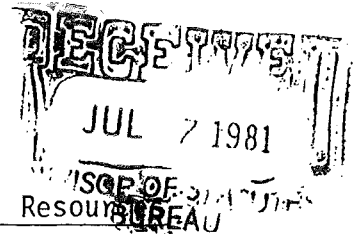

ORDER OF STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING RULES

*
IN THE MATTER OF amending section NR 20.04(3)(c)4.e. *
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to permit *
snagging of trout and salmon only in the streams *
tributary to Lake Michigan upstream to the first *
dam and on a specified portion of the lakeshore. *

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The rule amends s. NR 20.04(3)(c)4.e., Wis. Admin. Code, to remove current provisions allowing snagging while fishing from shore on the Lake Michigan shoreline. This amendment was requested by the City of Manitowoc and by petition from Manitowoc County citizens. Snagging would still be permitted in specified areas of tributary streams upstream to the first dam, and along the shoreline within 300 feet of the mouth of the Little Manitowoc River.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resource Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174, 227.014, and 227.015, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting s. 29.174, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section NR 20.04(3)(c)4.e. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

e. Manitowoc county - Lake-Michigan-shoreline-while-fishing-from-shore
except-within-500-feet-of-any-public-utility-discharge-flume,-and-all-streams

~~tributary-to-Lake-Michigan-upstream-to-the-first-dam.~~ East Twin river from the 17th Street bridge in the city of Two Rivers upstream to the first dam, West Twin river from the Washington Street bridge in the city of Two Rivers upstream to the first dam, Manitowoc river from the 8th Street bridge in the city of Manitowoc upstream to the first dam, Little Manitowoc river and the Lake Michigan shoreline while fishing from shore within 300 feet of the mouth of the Little Manitowoc river.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on April 23, 1981.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.061(1) (intro.), Stats.

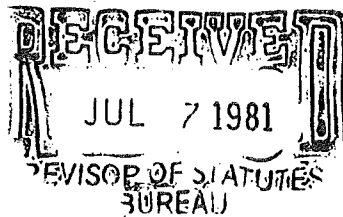




Dear Mr. Prestegard:
