ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The effect of this amendment is to allow the Department to establish effluent limitations based on federal regulations in state-issued Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) permits during a longer period of time than currently allowed under the existing code.

The reason for this rule is that the U.S. EPA is much later in developing regulations upon which Department rules must be based than was expected when the rule was first created. The ability of industry to comply with these regulations, and associated statutory deadlines, will be seriously jeopardized if the Department must first codify these regulations into the administrative code, before they can be used as a basis for permit limitations. This revision will remove the deadline for the authority to use federal regulations until the administrative code is promulgated. The effect of creating s. NR 205.04(3m) is to define the abbreviation BCT. The reason for this definition is to allow its use in other related administrative codes.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 147.04 and 227.014, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules interpreting s. 147.04, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 205.04(3m) is created to read:

(3m) "BCT" means best conventional pollutant control technology.

SECTION 2. NR 207.02 is amended to read:

<u>NR 207.02 APPLICABILITY</u>. This chapter is applicable to discharge permits issued during-the-period-of-June-1,-1981-through-December-31,-1982 for all categories and classes of point sources listed in s. NR 220.02,-Wis.-Adm.-Gode.

SECTION 3. NR 207.04 is amended to read:

<u>NR 207.04 ESTABLISHMENT OF LIMITATIONS BASED UPON FEDERAL REGULATIONS</u>. In the event that federal regulations establishing BGT-or-BAT effluent guidelines have been promulgated for a point source included in one of the categories and classes of point sources listed in s. NR 220.02, Wis--Adm--Gode, the department may establish in the discharge permit for such source, effluent limitations based upon these federal regulations,-provided-that. Prior to permit modification or renewal, the federally promulgated guidelines shall be used for enforcement purposes except where permit conditions and limitations are based on water quality or where standards have been promulgated under s. 147.035(3), Stats.

(1)--The-federal-regulations-are-promulgated-during-the-period September-1,-1980-through-Becember-31,-1982;-and

{2}--The-discharge-permit-is-issued-or-reissued-during-the-period-June-1; 1981-through-December-31;-1982;

SECTION 4. NR 207.05 is amended to read:

<u>NR 207.05 ESTABLISHMENT OF EFFLUENT GUIDELINE LIMITATIONS IN THE WISCONSIN</u> <u>ADMINISTRATIVE CODE</u>. The department shall, as soon as possible after the promulgation of any federal regulations establishing BGT-or-BAT effluent guidelines for certain categories and classes of point sources, adopt appropriate effluent guideline limitations for such point sources in the Wisconsin administrative code.

SECTION 5. NR 207.06 is amended to read:

<u>NR 207.06 PROVISION FOR MODIFICATION</u>. Any WPDES permits containing effluent limitations established under s. NR 207.04 shall be modified under s. 147.03, Stats., to reflect <u>any changes in</u> applicable BGT-or-BAT effluent limitations later promulgated in the Wisconsin administrative code.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on October 27, 1982.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.
