ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING RULES FEB 161983 IN THE MATTER of amending ss. NR 21.02(2) and 22.02(2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating to minimum size limits for commercially sold "dressed" catfish taken from the Mississippi River.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The present minimum size limit for catfish taken commercially from the Mississippi River boundary waters is 15 inches. No minimum size limit is provided for "dressed" (head and viscera removed but the tail on) catfish. Many commercial fishers sell "dressed" catfish. It has been determined that the minimum size limit for a "dressed" catfish needs to be 12 inches if it was legally taken at the minimum 15-inch length. The adoption of this rule will enhance enforcement and provide better protection for this species.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174, 29.175, 227.014(2)(a) and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting ss. 29.01, 29.085 and 29.174, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 21.02(2) is amended to read:

(2) Commercial fish include species of rough and detrimental fish as defined by this chapter, shovelnose (hackleback) sturgeon 25 inches and over in length taken only on setlines, catfish 15 inches or over in length or 12 inches and over dressed and bullheads having-a-minimum-length-of 9 inches or over in length or 7 inches and over dressed with-head-off-and-tail-on-or-9 inches-in-the-round, when taken with commercial fishing gear and all taken

while fishing under a commercial fishing license on the Mississippi river.

SECTION 2. NR 22.02(2) is amended to read:

(2) "Commercial fish" means species of rough <u>and detrimental</u> fish as defined in this chapter, shovelnose (hackleback) sturgeon 25 inches and over in length, catfish 15 inches or over in length <u>or 12 inches or over dressed</u> and bullheads having-a-minimum-length-of <u>9 inches or over in length or</u> 7 inches <u>and over dressed with-head-off-and-tail-on-or-9-inches-in-the-round</u> when taken with commercial fishing gear under a commercial fishing license.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 17, 1982.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
