## ORDER OF STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 20.03(1)(e)3.; and amending s. NR 20.03(1)(a)1. & (e)2. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to establish a 34-inch length limit on muskellunge in 2 lakes and a 14-inch length limit on largemouth bass in one lake.

## Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The rule establishes a 34-inch minimum length limit on muskellunge in Lake Winter, Sawyer County and Long Lake, Iron County as well as a 14-inch minimum length limit on largemouth bass in Zanders Lake, Green County. These rules are for testing length limits. The order also repeals s. NR 20.03(1)(e)3. that establishes a 34-inch length limit on muskellunge from Bone Lake, Polk County, and includes its provisions in the new rule.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources
Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174, 227.014(2)(a) and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the State
of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and amends rules as
follows:

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(a)1. is amended to read:

1. Park lake and Silver lake, Columbia county; Forest lake, Fond du Lac county; Beekmann Beckman lake and Zanders lake, Green county; Blue Spring lake, Jefferson county; and Little Elkhart lake, Sheboygan county (largemouth bass)	First Saturday in May to March 1	5	14

Browns lake, Racine county and Pretty lake, Waukesha county (largemouth bass)	First Saturday May to March 1	in	5	16
Rockland lake, Racine county and Beulah lake, Walworth county (largemouth bass)	First Saturday May to March 1	in	5	No minimum length, except the possession of fish between 12 and 16 inches is prohibited.

SECTION 2. NR 20.03(1)(e)2. is amended to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)
2. Long lake, Iron county; Winter lake, Sawyer county; Bone lake, Polk county; and Big lake (sec. 4, T42N, R6E), Vilas county	First Saturday in May to November 30	7	34

SECTION 3. NR 20.03(1)(e)3. is repealed.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 15, 1982.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
