ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYE TRUST FUNDS REPEALING RULES

To repeal chapter Ret 1 relating to the functioning of the Wisconsin retirement board.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Employe Trust Funds

This order is housekeeping in nature. The provisions of sections Ret 1.01 and 1.03 are statutory. Sections Ret 1.02 and 1.05 are procedural in nature and therefore unnecessary. It is necessary to repeal s. Ret 1.11 as it conflicts with statute.

These rules interpret ss. 15.07 (2) and (3) (a), and 40.03 (1) and (2), Stats.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Employe Trust Funds by s. 40.03 (2) (i), Stats., as created by ch. 96, Laws of 1981, the Department of Employe Trust Funds hereby repeals rules interpreting ss. 15.07 (2) and (3) (a), and 40.03 (1) and (2), Stats., as created by ch. 96, Laws of 1981, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter Ret 1 is repealed.
