ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

REPEALING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing ch. NR 33 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to sustained yield forestry

Fo-50-83

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Section 70.335, Stats., "Valuation and Assessment of Sustained Yield Forest Lands" was created to allow the lands owned by Menominee Enterprises, Inc., to be managed on a sustained yield principle as a requirement of termination of tribal status by the federal government. Chapter NR 33 provided the procedures for cutting notices, timber scaling, withdrawal of lands, reentry of lands and transfer of ownership.

After Menominee County was returned to tribal status by an Act of Congress, s. 70.335, Stats., was no longer necessary. Section 70.335, Stats., was repealed by ch. 224, Laws of 1977, effective April 7, 1978. With the statutory authority for ch. NR 33 repealed, the code chapter is also being repealed.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by s. 227.02(1)(b), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals rules interpreting s. 70.335, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 33 is repealed.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on October 26, 1983.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.


