An order to amend ILHR 8.05, ILHR 16.03, ILHR 45.13, ILHR 48.02 (5), ILHR 50.25, Ind 4.04, Ind 7.05, Ind 8.135 and Ind 9.34; to repeal and recreate ILHR 84.03, relating to petitions for variance.

ANALYSIS OF PROPOSED RULES

The Division of Safety and Buildings within the department has recently proposed changes in the petition fees contained in chapter Ind 69 - Fee Schedule. As part of those changes, the word "modification" was changed to "variance". In order to maintain consistency with other division chapters, the proposed rules change the wording in the applicable chapters which currently contain petition for modification requirements.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by s. 101.02 (1) and (6), Stats., the department hereby amends rules interpreting s. 101.02 (6), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. ILHR 8.05 is amended to read:

ILHR 8.05 (title) PETITION FOR VARIANCE. The department shall consider and may grant a modification variance to an administrative rule upon receipt of a fee and a completed petition for modification variance form (form SB-8) from the owner, provided an equivalency is established in the petition for modification variance which meets the intent of the rule being petitioned. The department may impose specific conditions in a petition for modification variance to promote the protection of the health, safety or welfare of the employes or the public. Violation of those conditions under which the petition for modification is granted constitutes a violation of these rules.

SECTION 2. ILHR 16.03 is amended to read;
