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

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE
ADOPTING RULES

AN ORDER to amend Tax 12.05(3), 12.06(2)(a)1a, (b)1a and (c)1a, 12.065(2) and 12.07(2)(b); and to create Tax 12.055 and 12.065(5)(a)4 and (b)8, relating to assessor certification requirements.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Revenue

The passage of Wisconsin Act 91 effective January 1, 1984 created s. 227.0105, Stats. The law requires agencies to submit proposed revisions to applicable rules specifying the number of business days within which the agency will review and make a determination on a permit application. In the attached order temporary assessor certification and assessor certification exams are considered "permits" as defined in the newly created s. 560.41(2); s. Tax 12.05(3) is amended and ss. Tax 12.055(1) and (2), 12.065(5)(a)4 and 12.065(5)(b)8. are created to interpret and implement ss. 73.09(1), (4), (5) and (7), stats. and to comply with the new requirement. The order also makes minor technical corrections to ss. Tax 12.06(2)(a)1a, (2)(b)1a and (2)(c)1a to incorporate sex neutral reference to certified assessors.

S. Tax 12.07(2)(b) is amended to correctly identify the new incorporations of the Town of Ashwaubenon as the Village of Ashwaubenon and the Town of Fitchburg as the City of Fitchburg as municipalities requiring Assessor 2 levels of certification.

Statement of Statutory Authority

Pursuant to the authority vested in the department of revenue by s. 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the department hereby amends and creates rules interpreting s. 73.09(1) and (6), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Tax 12.05(3) (intro.) is amended to read:

- (3) WHEN VALID. Temporary assessor certification shall become effective upon the mailing of a letter of approval by the department of revenue. The letter of approval shall be mailed within 5 business days of receipt by the department of an application as described in sub. (2). Temporary certification shall expire after whichever of the following first occurs:

SECTION 2. Tax 12.055 is created to read:

TAX 12.055 ASSESSOR CERTIFICATION EXAMINATIONS. (s. 73.09(5) Stats.)

- (1) EXAMINATIONS. Assessor certification examinations shall be held at the discretion of the department of revenue.
- (2) RESULTS. Individuals who have taken an assessor certification examination shall be notified as to whether the individual has passed or failed that examination within 25 business days after the exam.

SECTION 3. Tax 12.06(2)(a)1.a. is amended to read:

- 1.a. Serving as statutory assessor in an assessment district with a degree of complexity requiring the level of assessor 1 as determined by the department of revenue which shall include responsibility for all assessed values of real and personal property in the assessment district for which ~~he/she~~ the individual is statutory assessor;

SECTION 4. Tax 12.06(2)(b)1.a. is amended to read:

- 1.a. Serving as statutory assessor in an assessment district with a degree of complexity requiring the level of assessor 2 as determined by the department of revenue which shall include responsibility for all assessed values of real and personal property in the assessment district for which ~~he/she~~ the individual is statutory assessor;

SECTION 5. Tax 12.06(2)(c)1.a. is amended to read:

- 1.a. Serving as statutory assessor in an assessment district with a degree of complexity as determined by the department of revenue at the level of assessor 3 which shall include responsibility for all assessed value of real and personal property in the assessment district for which ~~he/she~~ the individual is statutory assessor;

SECTION 6. Tax 12.065(2)(e) is amended to read:

- (e) An applicant or instructor may apply ~~earning~~ continuing education hours only once for the same program during any given recertification period.

SECTION 7. Tax 12.065(5)(a)4. is created to read:

4. The school or individual submitting a completed application as described in sub. (1) shall be notified of the department's approval or rejection regarding the application within 45 days of the receipt of the application.

SECTION 8. Tax 12.065(5)(b)8. is created to read:

8. The school or program sponsor submitting a completed application as described in sub. (1) shall be notified of the department's approval or rejection regarding the application within 45 days of the receipt of the application.

SECTION 9. Tax 12.07(2)(b) is amended to read:


