IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT : OF TRANS 269.07(2), WISCONSIN : ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING : ORDER TO PERMITS FOR OPERATION OF : ADOPTING OVERSIZE AND OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES : RULE EOUIPPED WITH SELF-COMPACTORS : AND TRANSPORTING GARBAGE OR : REFUSE :

### Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

General summary of rule. The size and weight of vehicles operating on Wisconsin highways is subject to the restrictions established by the Legislature in Chapter 348 of the statutes. The federal government has also established size and weight regulations which are applicable to the national system of interstate and defense highways. 23 U.S.C. § 127 provides that no federal highway aids shall be apportioned to states which permit the operation of vehicles that exceed the maximum gross weights specified in 23 U.S.C. § 127 on interstate and defense highways within state boundaries.

However, the federal law recognizes that some exceptions are necessary for those vehicles and loads which cannot be easily dismantled or divided. Such oversize and overweight vehicles may operate on the system of interstate and defense highways with special permits issued under state law. Section 348.27(12), Stats., created by Chapter 163 of the Laws of 1981, published April 8, 1982, authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue special annual permits for the transportation of garbage or refuse in a self-compactor equipped vehicle that exceeds statutory weight and length limitations and for the return of the vehicle when empty.

Since loads of garbage or refuse may be considered to be divisible, the operation of overweight vehicles equipped with self-compactors and transporting garbage or refuse on interstate and defense highways in Wisconsin could jeopardize Wisconsin's eligibility for apportionment of federal highway funds. This proposed rulemaking order will allow operation under permits issued pursuant to s. 348.27(12), Stats., on all highways in Wisconsin except the national system of interstate and defense highways under s. 84.29, Stats.

#### RULE TEXT

Pursuant to the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, department of transportation, by ss. 110.06(1) and 348.25(3), Stats., the department of transportation hereby amends a rule interpreting and implementing sec. 348.27(12), Stats., as follows:

Section 1. Trans 269.07(2) is amended to read:

Trans 269.07(2) Permits issued by the department authorize the use of any of the highways of the state, <u>except those in the</u> <u>national system of interstate and defense highways under s. 84.29,</u> <u>Stats.</u>, subject to the limitations stated in the permit.
