Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

1983 Wisconsin Act 91 provides that rules promulgated by a department which require businesses to obtain a permit, as defined in s. 560.41(2), Stats., must specify the number of business days within which the department will review and make a determination on a permit application. The proposed rule amends chapter NR 154, the Air Pollution Control administrative code, to specify that all permit applications (for which another time period for review has not been specified by law) will be reviewed and a determination made within a specific number of business days (either 10 or 65 business days) after the department receives the application. Sixty-five business days is approximately equivalent to 90 calendar days.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 144.31, 227.0105 and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules interpreting ss. 144.31 and 227.0105, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 154.015 is created to read:

NR 154.015 DEPARTMENT REVIEW TIMES. Unless another time period is specified by law, the department shall complete its review and make a determination on all applications for permits and approvals listed under this section within the number of business days indicated, based on the date of receipt of the application.

(1) Alternate fuel variances under s. NR 154.02(4) - 10 business days;

- (2) Temporary excess emissions plans under s. NR 154.09(1)(b) 65 business days; and
- (3) Use of emergency or reserve equipment under s. NR 154.09(1)(c) 65 business days.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on October 24, 1984

The rules herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.
