

6 To repeal Ag 10.62 relating to the embargo on poultry and
7 poultry products from states having avian influenza outbreak.

Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of
Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection

An emergency rule was adopted on November 6, 1984, relating to the movement of poultry, poultry products and related materials from the states of Pennsylvania, Maryland and Virginia into Wisconsin. This repeal permanently ends the prohibition from Wisconsin of such products. The rule repealed here was enacted to prevent the spread of avian influenza to Wisconsin because of possible catastrophic losses to the poultry industry of Wisconsin, due to bird mortality and loss of future markets. Because of eradication programs undertaken by the states of Pennsylvania, Maryland and Virginia and the U.S. Department of Agriculture, the local area quarantines have been released and no presence of latent avian influenza virus detected in recovered flocks.

This repeal is authorized by s. 93.07(1) and interprets ss. 95.19, 95.20 and 227.014(2), Stats.

10 ss. 93.07(1), 95.19, 95.20 and 227.014(2) Stats., the State of
11 Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection
12 repeals as follows:


13 SECTION 1. Ag 10.62 is repealed.
