STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION CREATING RULES

To create Chapter PI 22 relating to the criteria for the review and approval of

2	applications for minority group precollege scholarships.
	Analysis by the Department of Public Instruction
	Chapter 29 Laws of 1985 created s. 115.43, which establishes a minority group pupil precollege scholarship program. The purpose of the program is to award precollege scholarships, on a competitive basis, to minority group pupils in grades 6-12 who enroll in precollege classes or programs designed to improve academic skills that are essential for success in postsecondary school education. The rules list the components of a precollege program, establish application procedures, and outline criteria to be considered in awarding scholarships.
3	Pursuant to the authority vested in the department of public instruction by s. 115.43,
4	Stats., the state superintendent hereby creates rules interpreting s. 115.43, Stats., as follows:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter PI 22 is created to read:
6	Chapter PI 22
7	CRITERIA FOR THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR
8	UNDERREPRESENTED MINORITY GROUP PUPIL PRECOLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS.
9	PI 22.01 PURPOSE AND APPLICABILITY. The purpose of this chapter is to establish
10	policies and procedures to meet the requirement that minority group pupil precollege
11	scholarships, as authorized in s. 115.43, Stats., be awarded on a competitive basis and that

criteria for the review and approval of applications for scholarships be established.

1	PI 22.02 <u>DEFINITIONS</u> . In this chapter:
2	(1) "Department" means the department of public instruction.
3	(2) "Minority group pupil" means a pupil who is a Black American, an American
4	Indian, a Spanish-surnamed American or an Oriental American.
5	(3) "Postsecondary educational institutions" means the university of Wisconsin system
6	campuses, private four-year colleges and universities in Wisconsin, and the college parallel
7	programs offered through Wisconsin vocational, technical and adult education institutions.
8	(4) "Precollege programs" means classes or programs designed by postsecondary
9	educational institutions to improve pupils' academic skills necessary for success in college
10	study.
11	(5) "Scholarship program" means the minority group pupil precollege scholarship
12	program under s. 115.43, Stats.
13	(6) "State superintendent" means the superintendent of public instruction for the
14	state of Wisconsin.
15	(7) "WEOP" or "Wisconsin educational opportunity program" means a program within
16	the department which assists disadvantaged students to develop postsecondary school
17	plans.
18	PI 22.03 GENERAL. (1) The scholarship program shall provide scholarships to minor-
19	ity group pupils for precollege classes or programs.
20	(2) Minority group pupils in grades 6 through 12 are eligible for these scholarships.
21	(3) The department shall provide for follow-up studies of participants in the program.
22	PI 22.04 PRECOLLEGE PROGRAMS. (1) Postsecondary educational institutions
23	shall submit information on precollege programs for which minority group pupils may
24	receive scholarship awards to the state superintendent.
25	(2) Precollege programs shall include at least one of the following:
26	(a) Reinforcement in basic skills and competencies such as reading, writing,
27	speaking, listening, mathematics, and reasoning.

1	(b) Reinforcement in skills and attitudes necessary for success in college and
2	employment, including study skills, work habits, and instructor and employer expectations.
3	(c) Special experiences, such as computer camps, and workshops in science, mathe-
4	matics, writing, reading, arts and humanities.
5	(d) Reinforcement in employability skills and attitudes.
6	(3) Precollege programs may also include other components, such as the following:
7	(a) Information on financial aids available to all pupils and to minority pupils in
8	particular.
9	(b) Career guidance and counseling.
10	(c) Information on college living such as dormitory life and support groups.
11	(d) Information on college application procedures.
12	PI 22.05 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS. (1) The department shall develop, in
13	consultation with postsecondary school educational institutions, a scholarship application.
	NOTE: PI-1573, Precollege Minority Scholarship Application, is available from Division for School Financial Resources and Management Services, 125 South Webster Street, P.O. Box 7841, Madison, WI 53707.
14	(2) The department shall disseminate information and application forms to public
15	and private middle schools, junior high schools and secondary schools, WEOP offices, triba
16	education offices and postsecondary educational institutions with precollege programs.
17	Information and application forms shall be available to pupils from these schools and
18	offices.
19	(3) Annually, the department shall establish deadlines for scholarship applications in
20	consultation with school districts, colleges and universities.
21	(4) Scholarship applications shall consist of the following:
22	(a) The application form specified in subsection (1);
23	(b) Recommendation by a teacher, school counselor, or principal from the school
24	attended by the pupil, or from a WEOP staff member.

(c) A copy of the pupil's transcript or permanent record.

1	PI 22.06 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS. (1) Scholarship awards shall be made by the
2	state superintendent.
3	(2) Scholarship awards shall be competitive and shall be based on the following
4	criteria:
5	(a) Evidence of the pupil's potential ability to succeed in college.
6	(b) Evidence of the pupil's desire to succeed in college.
7	(c) Evidence of the pupil's potential to benefit from the precollege program.
8	(d) Recommendation of a teacher, counselor, principal, or WEOP staff member.
9	(3) Preference in scholarship awards, including those for programs in private col-
10	leges or colleges outside the University of Wisconsin system, shall be given to minority
11	group pupils who are inadequately represented in the university of Wisconsin system.
12	(4) The pupil shall have been accepted in a precollege program which meets the
13	criteria specified in s. PI 22.04.
14	(5) Qualified applicants are eligible for one or more scholarship awards contingent
15	on the availability of scholarship funds, however, a pupil may receive only one award per
16	semester or summer.
17	(6) Scholarship awards may not exceed the cost of the precollege program which
18	may include only tuition, books, supplies, and, if applicable, room and board.
19	(7) Scholarships shall be awarded to minority group pupils and paid to the enrolling
20	institution in the name of the recipient.
21	(8) If the number of qualified applicants exceeds the appropriation for the program
22	awards shall be made on a fully funded basis until the appropriation is exhausted. The
23	awards shall be made on a competitive basis.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.
