

Chapter S-L 7

COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNATION OF
LEGAL HOLIDAYS

S-L 7.01 Days on which associations must be closed S-L 7.02 Additional observance days permitted

Note: Chapter S-L 7 as it existed on May 31, 1977 was repealed and a new chapter S-L 7 was created effective June 1, 1977.

S-L 7.01 Days on which associations must be closed. (1) No association may be open for business on any of the following days:

- (a) January 1.
- (c) Last Monday in May.
- (d) July 4.
- (e) 1st Monday in September.
- (h) 4th Thursday in November.
- (i) December 25.
- (j) Good Friday from noon to 3 p.m.

(2) If any of the days designated in sub. (1) fall on a Sunday, the association may not be open for business on the succeeding Monday.

(3) Operation of a remote service unit as defined in s. 215.13 (46) (a) 2., Stats., or an unstaffed facility does not constitute the transaction of business for the purpose of this section.

S-L 7.02 Additional observance days permitted. An association's board of directors may designate additional days on which the association will not be open for business.
