ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD RENUMBERING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of renumbering s. NR 20.03(1)(c)4. and (d)5. and creating s. NR 20.03(1)(c)4. and (d)5. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to northern pike and walleye minimum size limits and bag limits in Lake . Mendota. Dane county.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Authorizing Statutes: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes Interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The proposed rules establish size and bag limits on northern pike and walleye in Lake Mendota, Dane County, that differ from the general statewide size and bag limits for these two fish species. The specific changes include:

- 1. A 32-inch minimum size limit for northern pike with a daily bag limit of one fish.
- 2. A 15-inch minimum size limit for walleye with a daily bag limit of 3 fish.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(c)4. is renumbered NR 20.03(1)(c)5.

SECTION 2. NR $20.03(1)(c)^3$, is created to read:

SECTION 3. NR 20.03(1)(d)5. is renumbered NR 20.03(1)(d)6.

SECTION 4. NR 20.03(1)(d)5. is created to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)
5. Lake Mendota, Dane county	First Saturday in May to March 1	1	32

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on October 29, 1987.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
