# ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF repealing and recreating ss. NR 10.01(2)(f)2. and 10.29 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to 1988 wild turkey hunting.

#### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Authorizing statutes: ss. 29.103, 29.174(2)(b) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats. Statutes Interpreted: s. 29.103, Stats.

The number of turkey hunting permits issued by the department controls the turkey harvest in 7 wild turkey hunting zones. The department proposes to increase the number of permits for these zones to 9,040 and modify the east boundary of zone 4. In 1987, 6,040 permits were issued and 1,485 wild turkeys were harvested.


