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Pursuant to the authority vested in the department of industry, labor and human relations by ss.101.26 and 101.02(1), Stats., the department of industry and human relations hereby creates rules interpreting s.101.27(6), Stats., as follows:

SECTION ... ILHR 816.02(9) is amended to read:

ILHR 816.02(9) "Farmer" means an individual 18 years of age or older whose primary employment is the operation of farm premises as described in s.101.27, Stats.

SECTION 2. ILHR 816.02(18) is repealed.

SECTION 3. ILHR 816.09 (1) (f) and (2) to (4) are amended to read:

SECTION 3. ILHR 816.09 (1) (f), HISTORY OF DEMONSTRATED POOR PERFORMANCE OR FISCAL NON-COMPLIANCE is amended to read:

The division will shall not award no points for this item. The division will shall inform the review panel of previous poor performance such as failure to achieve performance standards or continued performance below planned levels or fiscal non-compliance.

ILHR 816.09(2) Proposals that score 12 points in the initial screening shall qualify for referral to the review panel and secretary for consideration. In addition, the division shall provide the review panel with information described in sub.(1)(f), summaries of the qualifying proposals' consistency with factors listed in s.101.27, Stats., and recommendations for funding alternatives which will shall best fulfill the objectives of the dislocated workers plan.

ILHR 816.09(3) The review panel shall make recommendations to the secretary on the selection of grantees based on a request for proposals. The panel shall consider all of the factors listed in s.101.27, Stats. Severity of need may include factors such as the unemployment rate, the number of unemployed or dislocated workers and economic conditions of the area. Appropriate skill development or training may include factors such as the demand for the occupation in the area to which relocation assistance $\frac{1}{1}$ $\frac{1}{1}$ $\frac{1}{1}$ $\frac{1}{1}$ be provided. In addition, the review panel may consider geographic area to be served; any recommendations of the local private industry council and chief local elected officials; demonstrated effectiveness; cost effectiveness; placement rate; administrative capacity of the applicant; and ability to raise matching funds.

ILHR 816.09(4) The secretary $\frac{1}{4}$ shall receive and review recommendations from the review panel and shall render a final decision on funding.

SECTION 4. These rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s.227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
