ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

AMENDING A RULE

To amend Ins 17.28 (6) (intro.), (a) to (j), (m) 1 and (n), relating to health care provider fees for the patients compensation fund.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Statutory authority: ss. 601.41 (3) and 655.004, Stats.

Statute interpreted: s. 655.27 (3) (b) and (br), Stats.

This rule establishes, for fiscal year 1988-89, the fees for health care providers covered by the patients compensation fund. The amount of increase in the fees is based on the collection of the maximum amount permitted under state law, that is, 200% of the actual total claim payments by the fund during 1987.

SECTION 1. Ins 17.28 (6) (intro.), (a) to (j), (m) 1 and (n) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:
