ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 124.03(7) and .

(9) and creating s. NR 124.03(2m) of the

Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining
to the Individual Septic Tank Replacement . CA-8-88
or Rehabilitation Grant Program .

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 144.245 and 227.11(2)(a), Stats. Statutes interpreted: s. 144.245, Stats.

Grants for private sewage system rehabilitation or replacement are authorized under s. 144.245 Stats., and ch. NR 124. Grants are awarded to participating counties which distribute the funds to eligible individual applicants. Eligible structures include only owner-occupied principal residences or small commercial establishments constructed prior to July 1, 1978.

The proposed revision would increase the number of eligible applicants by doing the following:

- Create a definition of "farm" which is similar to the one used in the farmland preservation program under s. 91.01(6), Stats. Farm income language is not included in the proposed definition to avoid conflict with the grant program income limits established under s. 144.245(5)(d), Stats.
- Revise the definition of "principal residence" to include a residence owned by a trust or estate if the residence is occupied at least 51% of the year by a person who has an ownership interest in the property as a beneficiary of the trust or estate.
- Revise the definition of "small commercial establishment" to include a farm residence if it is occupied by a person who operates the farm.

SECTION 1. NR 124.03(2m) is created to read:

NR 124.03(2m) "Farm" means a parcel of 35 or more acres of contiguous land which is devoted primarily to agricultural use, as defined in s. 91.01(1) and (5), Stats.

SECTION 2. NR 124.03(7) is amended to read:

NR 124.03(7) "Principal residence" means a residence which is occupied at least 51% of the year by the owner. Principal residence includes a residence owned by a trust or estate of an individual, if the residence is occupied at least 51% of the year by a person who has an ownership interest in the residence as a beneficiary of the trust or estate.

SECTION 3. NR 124.03(9) is amended to read:

NR 124.03(9) "Small commercial establishment" means a commercial establishment or business place with a maximum daily wastewater flow rate of less than 2,100 gallons per day as determined from the design criteria of the state plumbing code. Small commercial establishment includes a farm, including a residence on a farm, if the residence is occupied by a person who is an operator of the farm and if the maximum daily wastewater flow rate of the farm and the residence on the farm is less than 2,100 gallons per day as determined from the design criteria of the state plumbing code.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on April 28, 1988.

The rules shall take effect the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
