

The Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations proposes to repeal and recreate ILHR 14.121(3), relating to flameproofing of Christmas trees.

Analysis of Proposed Rules

Statutory Authority: ss. 101.02(15)(a) and 101.14, Stats. Statutes Interpreted: ss. 101.02(15)(a) and 101.14, Stats.

The Safety and Buildings Division within the Department is responsible for administering and enforcing the General Hazard Fire Prevention Code, chapter ILHR 14. The proposed rule consists of an amendment to section ILHR 14.121(3) relating to flameproofing of live and artificial Christmas trees.

The proposed rule deletes the requirement for flameproofing of natural Christmas trees and requires artificial trees to be flame retardant or nonflammable. For natural Christmas trees, the rule incorporates the recommendations of the National Fire Protection Association to recut the tree trunk and maintain it in water.

SECTION 1. ILHR 14.121(3) is repealed and recreated to read:

ILHR 14.121(3) CHRISTMAS TREES. Artificial Christmas trees, except those within individual living units, shall be flame retardant or nonflammable. Natural Christmas trees, except those within individual living units, shall have the trunk sawed off at least one inch above the original cut end and shall be cut immediately prior to being placed in a water-bearing stand. The water level shall always be above the cut.
