ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

and creating ss. NR 10.001(10m) and 10.09(1)(d) .  
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining . LE-5-90  
to automatic firearms .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The proposed rule prohibits the use of fully automatic firearms, i.e., machine guns, for hunting and would prohibit the use of full metal jacket nonexpanding bullets for hunting deer and bear.

SECTION 1. NR 10.001(10m) is created to read:

NR 10.001(10m) "Fully automatic firearm" means any firearm which continues to fire or is manufactured to continue to fire as long as the trigger is depressed.

Note: This definition does not include a semi-automatic firearm which fires a single shot with each pull of the trigger, then ejects the spent cartridge case and reloads without effort on the part of the shooter.

SECTION 2. NR 10.09(1)(c)2. is amended to read:

NR 10.09(1)(c)2. Deer or bear hunting. Hunt any deer or bear with any .22 rim-fire, 5 mm rim-fire rifle, .17 caliber center-fire rifle, ~~or~~ .410 bore shotgun or with ammunition loaded with full metal jacket, nonexpanding type bullets.

SECTION 3. NR 10.09(1)(d) is created to read:

NR 10.09(1)(d) Automatic firearms. Hunt with a fully automatic firearm.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on April 26, 1990.

The rules shall take effect the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22 (2)(intro.), Stats.


