ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 20.03(1)(a)7. a. and b., (c)2.a. and b., and (d)4.a. and b.; and amending ss. NR 20.03(1)(d)4.a. and 20.04(3)(a) . FM-54-89 14., of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to sport fishing.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3), 227.11(2) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The proposed rule establishes an open season from the first Saturday in May to March 1 for largemouth bass, walleyes and northern pike in Beaver Dam Lake, Dodge County, and Ripon Millpond, Fond du Lac County. It also establishes a 26-inch size limit and a daily bag limit of 3 on northern pike in Beaver Dam Lake, Dodge County. The season was closed on these species in these lakes to protect them from harvest after the lake was treated with fish toxicants. The fish are now large enough to be desirable to anglers who should have the opportunity to harvest them. The restrictive regulation on northern pike is to maintain a high population of this species to maximize predation on rough fish and to furnish quality angling.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(a)7.a. and b., (c)2.a. and b., and (d) 4.b. are repealed.

SECTION 2. NR 20.03(1)(d)4.a. is amended to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open dates (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)
4.a. Beaver Dam lake, Dodge county	No open season First Saturday in May to March 1	<u>2</u>	<u>26</u>

SECTION 3. NR 20.04(3)(a)14. is amended to read:

NR 20.04(3)(a)14. Dodge County Beaver Dam, Lost and Sinnissippi

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on April 26, 1990 & June 28, 1990.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
