An order of the Veterinary Examining Board to create VE 7.06 (21) of the administrative code relating to scope of practice.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

#### ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) (a) and 453.03, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 453.07, Stats.

In this proposed order the Veterinary Examining Board creates subsection VE 7.06 (21) defining unprofessional conduct. The new rule is intended to address the problem of a veterinarian exceeding the scope of practice of veterinary medicine by treating humans or by dispensing to humans drugs intended only for veterinary use.

#### TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. VE 7.06 (21) is created to read:

VE 7.06 (21) Exceeding the scope of veterinary practice, as defined in s. 453.02 (6), Stats., by providing medical treatment to humans or distributing, prescribing or dispensing for human use prescription drugs, as defined in s. 450.01 (20), Stats., or any drug labelled for veterinary or animal use only.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22(2)(intro), Stats.
