

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ORDER

An order of the Department of Regulation and Licensing to amend RL 4.04 (3) of the administrative code relating to examination fees.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) (a), and 440.06, Stats.

Statute interpreted: s. 440.05 (1), Stats.

In this proposed order, the Department of Regulation and Licensing creates new examination fees, eliminates dated fee information, changes examination titles, eliminates fees for examinations, corrects an omission of a license fee, and increases certain fees to reflect increases in costs.

Examination fees are created for occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants. The new licenses were established by chapter 448, Stats., effective June, 1989.

Dated fee information messages, e.g. "effective \_\_\_\_\_, 1988", are eliminated and fees are updated.

Examination titles are changed for Optometrist, Physical Therapist, and Physician's Assistant.

Fees for engineers, land surveyors, and all licenses related to barbering and cosmetology are eliminated. These examinations will no longer be administered by the department.

Fees for dentists are added to the rule to correct an omission from the previous rule. Fees are the minimum established by s. 440.05 (1), Stats.

Fees for nursing home administrator, physical therapist, and psychologist are increased to reflect the actual cost of purchase of the examination booklet from the sole-source provider.

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TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. RL 4.04 (3) is amended to read:
