Statutory authority: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) (a), 448.01 (11) and 448.40, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 448.02 and 448.05, Stats.

In this order the Medical Examining Board proposes to create subsection Med 10.02 (2) (x) prohibiting a physician from prescribing or dispensing anabolic steroids for athletic purposes or for other nonmedical purposes.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Med 10.02 (2) (x) is created to read:

Med 10.02 (2) (x) Prescribing, ordering, dispensing, administering, supplying, selling or giving any anabolic steroid for the purposes of enhancing athletic performance or for other nonmedical purposes.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22 (2) (intro), Stats.
