ORDER

An order of the Veterinary Examining Board to amend VE 2.01 (1) and (2) and VE 3.02 (3) of the administrative code relating to examinations.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) and 453.03, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 453.065, Stats.

In this order the Veterinary Examining Board is amending rules relating to qualification to sit for the examinations required for licensure as a veterinarian. These rules were repealed and recreated by Clearinghouse Rule 88-203 and, as recreated, have led to confusion whether the requirement set forth at VE 2.01 (2) refers to qualification to sit for the state board examination or for the national examinations. This revision is intended to clarify the board's intent.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. VE 2.01 (1) and (2) are amended to read:

- VE 2.01 <u>ADMINISTRATION</u>. (1) The board or its designee shall administer at-least-one-examination-each-year-to-applicants-for-licensure-as-a veterinarian-or-eertification-as-an-animal-technician the examinations required of applicants for licensure as a veterinarian by s. VE 3.02 and of applicants for certification as an animal technician by s. VE 8.02 at least once each year.
- (2) To be qualified to sit for the national board examination and clinical competency test, an applicant must have either graduated from or be a last year student at a school of veterinary medicine approved by the board or a foreign school of veterinary medicine listed by the American veterinary medical association. To be qualified to sit for the state board examination, an applicant must meet the requirements of s. VE 3.03.

SECTION 2. VE 3.02 (3) is amended to read:

VE 3.02 (3) Has passed a state board examination conducted by the board under-ehr-VE-2 as evidenced by documents submitted directly to the board by the department's office of examinations;

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22(2)(intro), Stats.
