## ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF amending ss. NR 20.03(5).

(g) Table 1 and NR 23.05(5)(g) of the FM-35-90

to sport fishing.

## Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3), 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The order makes corrections and adjustments in inland trout regulations that were first instituted in 1990. Specifically, the changes:

- a. Add an extended season from September 30 until March 1 on 80 lakes.
- b. Add a special regulation of a 3 bag limit and no size limit in urban waters in 8 southeastern counties, and
- c. Make specific changes on 61 waters in 33 counties that deal with category changes, boundary descriptions and size limit changes.

The order also increases the size limit and decreases the bag limit on the Wisconsin-Michigan boundary water Brule River in Forest and Florence Counties.
