The proposed rules:

- 1. Establish permit levels for the 1991 spring turkey season.
- 2. Open 1 additional turkey hunting zone for spring 1991 turkey hunting.
- 3. Enlarge the boundaries of turkey hunting zones 9 and 32.
- 4. Modify the application deadlines for turkey hunting to August 10 for fall permits and to December 10 for spring permits.



3. All fall hunting applications shall be postmarked no later than the -Friday nearest August 10 or received by the department license section no later than 4:30 p.m. on that Friday day to be considered for the fall turkey hunting season established in s. NR 10.01(2)(f)3.
