IN THE MATTER of repealing ss. NR 20.03(1)(d)3. and 20.04(3)(am)2.; amending ss. NR 20.03(1) (d)5 and (e)3., 20.04(3)(a)69. and (am)9., and 21.04(7) and (11)(a); and repealing and recreating s. NR 21.02(9) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to sport fishing.

### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Authorizing statutes: ss. 29.174(3), 227.11(2) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085 and 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

#### The Order:

- 1. Closes the season on lake sturgeon on the Mississippi river, increases the minimum size limit on the remaining portions of the Wisconsin-Minnesota Boundary Waters from 45 to 50 inches and reduces the length of the open season from the period of the Saturday closest to May 1 to October 31 to the period of the first Saturday in September to October 15.
- 2. Increases the minimum size limit of muskellunge on the Wisconsin-Minnesota Boundary Waters from 30 to 36 inches.
- 3. Shortens the continuous open season on most game fish species to the normal statewide season which is the period from the first Saturday in May to March 1 on the following waters:
  - a. Black River from Black River Falls to its confluence with the Mississippi River.
  - b. Hatch, Silver and White lakes, Waupaca County.
  - c. Grand River from Fairwater in Fond du Lac County downstream to the Grand River Wildlife Area dam in Marquette County, including the Grand River Marsh.
  - d. Shawano Lake, Shawano County (northern pike only).
  - e. all waters of Menominee County (northern pike only).

4. Reduces the daily bag limit from 25 to 5 on northern pike in Shawano lake, Shawano county and all waters of Menominee county.

- 5. Establishes a 32 inch size limit and reduces the bag limit from 2 to 1 on northern pike on Silver lake, Kenosha county.
- 6. Establishes a 32 inch size limit on northern pike and closes the muskellunge season on Long lake, Waushara county.
- 7. Clarifies the definition of Mississippi River used in the Wisconsin Minnesota Boundary Waters rules to ensure that the Burlington Northern railroad tracks serve as the regulatory boundary between the boundary waters and inland waters.
