FINAL DRAFT

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Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations under ss. 101.02(1) and 105.15, Wis. Stats., the department hereby creates s. Ind 77.01(8) and Ind 77.025(1) and (2) and repeals ss. Ind. 77.06(2)f, Ind 77.09(1)(e) and Ind 77.09(2)(e), Wis. Adm. Code, relating to the licensing and registration of employer-paid fee private employment agents.

ANALYSIS

This rule changes the licensing requirement for employer-paid fee private employment agents to a registration requirement.

It further repeals language dealing with Class V licenses which applied to employer-paid fee agents.

SECTION 1. Ind 77.01(4m) is created to read:

Ind 77.01(4m) "Employer-paid fee employment agent" means a private employment agent whose fees or charges are paid entirely and directly by the employer to the employment agent.

SECTION 2. Ind 77.015 is created to read:

Ind 77.015 EMPLOYER-PAID FEE EMPLOYMENT AGENT REGISTRATION.

(1) All employer-paid fee employment agents shall pay a \$5.00 registration fee and register with the department by July 1 of each year for the period of July 1 through June 30 of the following year.

(2) The five dollar registration fee covers all business locations of the requesting agent.

SECTION 3. Ind 77.06(2)(f), 77.09(1)(e), and 77.09(2)(e) are repealed.

SECTION 4. Ind 77.15 (title) is amended to read:

Ind 77.15 APPLICANT-PAID FEE AGENTS. Advertising and Advertisements.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Pursuant to s. 227.22(2)(intro), Stats., these rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register.
