

The proposed rules establish four beaver management zones and trapping seasons as follows:

- Zone A - Northwest Wisconsin - Saturday nearest October 21 through March 15.
- Zone B - Northeast Wisconsin - Saturday nearest October 21 through April 30.
- Zone C - Southcentral Wisconsin - December 1 through March 15.
- Zone D - Mississippi River - Day after duck season through March 15.




