

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT

AMENDING CHAPTER DOD 17

WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

The Department of Development adopts an order to amend Chapter DOD 17 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating to the Business Development Initiative Program.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Development.

Sections 234.965 and 560.18, Stats., creates a business development initiative program and s. 560.02(4), Stats., authorizes the department to adopt rules required to administer that program.

The proposed order adds a new consideration the department must make before providing technical assistance or making a technical assistance grant. That consideration is the extent to which the creation or expansion of the for-profit business is expected to create business ownership or management opportunities for persons with severe disabilities and persons with severe disabilities who are minority group members.

Text of Rule

SECTION 1. Section DOD 17.04(3)(a)(intro.) is amended to read:
DOD 17.04(3)(a)(intro.) The ownership and ownership structure of the for-profit business that will be the beneficiary of the technical assistance or grant including identification of any person with severe disabilities involved in the ownership or management.

SECTION 2. Section DOD 17.04(4)(e) is created to read:
DOD 17.04(4)(e) The extent to which the expansion or creation of the for-profit business is expected to create business ownership or management opportunities for persons with severe disabilities and persons with severe disabilities who are minority group members.

EFFECTIVE DATE. The regulations set forth in this order shall be effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
