SECTION 1. Ind 88.12 is amended to read:

Ind 88.12 In any case set for hearing, pre-hearings may be held in accordance with the provisions of $s = 227 \cdot 07(4) \frac{s}{s} \cdot 227 \cdot 44(4)$, Stats.

SECTION 2. Ind 88.14(2) is amended to read:

Ind 88.14(2) A party may obtain discovery prior to hearing, except that discovery directed to a complaint complainant who is not represented by legal counsel shall not be permitted in the absence of written consent by the administrative law judge. The scope of discovery, the methods of discovery and the use of discovery at hearing will be the same as set forth in ch. 804, Stats. The administrative law judge has the same authority to compel discovery, to issue protective orders and to impose sanctions as the court has under ch. 804, Stats. Copies of all demands for discovery and responses to demands for discovery shall be filed with the division when they are served. Discovery may not be used prior to the time that a matter is certified to hearing, except that the taking and preservation of evidence shall be permitted prior to certification to hearing under the circumstances set forth in $s_{7-227-08(7)}$ s. 227.45(7), Stats.

SECTION 3. Ind 88.18(5) and Ind 89.22(4) are repealed. This section will apply to decisions which are-issued after the effective date of this rule.

SECTION 4. Ind 89.23(3) is amended to read:

Ind 89.23(3) A petition for review of any decision which is appealable to the labor and industry review commission, other than as set forth in $\frac{\text{sub.}(1)}{\text{sub.}(2)}$, shall be filed within 21 days after the date that a copy of the administrative law judge's decision and order is mailed to the last know known addresses of the parties.

SECTION 5. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
