ORDER

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to create Chir 6.015 and Chir 6.02 (27) and (28) of the administrative code relating to patient health care records and standards of conduct.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 446.04, Stats.

In this order the Chiropractic Examining Board is creating Chir 6.015 defining the requirements for maintaining patient records and for making the records available for the use or benefit of the patient to whom the records relate in accordance with ss. 146.81, 146.82 and 146.83, Stats. Chir 6.02 (27) and (28) are created to define noncompliance with maintaining patient records and with making the records available for the use or benefit of the patient to whom the records relate to be unprofessional conduct.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 6.015 is created to read:

Chir 6.015 (title) <u>DEFINITIONS</u>. "Patient health care records" means all records related to the health of a patient prepared by or under the supervision of a chiropractor.

SECTION 2. Chir 6.02 (27) and (28) are created to read:

Chir 6.02 (27) Failing to maintain patient health care records for a minimum period of 7 years after the last treatment or after the patient reaches the age of majority, whichever is greater.

(28) Failing to release patient health care records to a patient in accordance with s. 146.83, Stats.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
