# RULES in FINAL DRAFT FORM

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**Rule No.:** Section Ind 69.11(1m)

**Relating to:** Vapor Recovery Grant Program

Clearinghouse Rule No: 91-160

The Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations proposes an order to create section Ind 69.11(1m), relating to the vapor recovery grant program and petroleum product inspection fee.

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Analysis of Proposed Rules

Statutory Authority: Section 168.12(1r), as created by 1991 Wisconsin Act 39  
Statutes Interpreted: Sections 168.12(1r), as created by 1991 Wisconsin Act 39

The proposed rule consists of the creation of section Ind 69.11(1m), relating to the collection of fees for the inspection of petroleum products. As specified in section 168.12(1r), Stats., as created by 1991 Wisconsin Act 39, the rule requires the Department to charge an oil inspection fee of 50 cents for each 50 gallons of petroleum product from which a sample is taken. This 50-cent fee is in addition to any other fees charged for the inspection of petroleum products. The new fee will be charged beginning with inspections performed on September 1, 1991 and will end on October 31, 1992. The revenues generated through this increase are to be transferred to the Department of Natural Resources for their implementation of a vapor recovery grant program for retail gas stations.

The proposed rule has been in effect as an emergency rule since August 30, 1991.

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SECTION 1. Ind 69.11 (1m) is created to read:

Ind 69.11 (1m) VAPOR RECOVERY GRANT PROGRAM. Beginning on September 1, 1991, the department shall charge an oil inspection fee, in addition to any other fees, of \$0.50 for each 50 gallons from which petroleum product samples were taken for the vapor recovery grant program. No fees may be charged under this subsection after October 31, 1992.
