ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF repealing s. NR 23.06; renumbering . ss. NR 23.07 to 23.12; amending ss. NR 23.05(5) . (intro), (a) and (b) and 23.07; repealing and . recreating s. NR 23.05(5)(d), (e), (f) and (h); . FM-18-93 and creating s. NR 23.05(5)(j) of the Wisconsin . Administrative Code pertaining to sport fishing in . Wisconsin-Michigan boundary waters

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085 and 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

In this order, SECTION 1 establishes a daily bag of 25 in total for bluegill, crappie, white and yellow bass, yellow perch, and sunfish. SECTION 1 also provides that there is no closed season, size limit, or daily bag limit for kinds of fish not specifically listed.

SECTION 2 establishes a catch-and-release early season (first Saturday in May to the Friday nearest June 20) for largemouth and smallmouth bass and increases the minimum length limit for bass in Smokey Lake from 12 to 16 inches. The muskellunge length limit is increased from 30 to 40 inches and 3 distinct muskellunge fishing seasons are replaced with one uniform season (May 15 to November 30) for all Wisconsin-Michigan boundary waters. Section 2 also reduces the daily bag limit for walleyes in rivers and impoundments from 5 to one during March and April.

SECTION 3 adds catfish as a species listed in the boundary waters table. Catfish regulations were previously cross-referenced to the inland regulations section. This housekeeping action does not change catfish rules.

SECTION 4 repeals the January and February spearing season for northern pike, redhorse, sucker and carp on the Menominee and Brule rivers and their impoundments.

SECTION 5 renumbers ss. NR 23.07 through 23.12 and deletes an obsolete cross-reference.

NR 23.05(5)(intro.) The seasons, size limits and bag and possession limits for hook and line fishing in the Wisconsin - Michigan boundary waters for the species listed in this subsection, except as provided in ss. s. NR 23.06 and 23.07 are as follows. Fishing for species not listed in this subsection is subject to ch. NR 20.

SECTION 4. NR 23.06 is repealed.

SECTION 5. NR 23.07 to 23.12 are renumbered to be NR 23.06 to 23.11, respectively, and NR 23.07, as renumbered, is amended to read:

NR 23.07 MINNOWS. No person may sell, trade or barter minnows taken from Wisconsin - Michigan boundary waters. Except as provided in ss. NR 20.09(2)(g) and (3), and 21.06(1)(d) and $\frac{23.07}{23.06}$, no person may take fish other than smelt and shiners with nets or traps in the Montreal river downstream from the Superior Falls dam.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 24, 1993

The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1994, pursuant to authority granted by s. 227.22(2)(b), Stats.
