

- SECTION 1. DOD 14.03 (4) (b) and 14.04 (3) (intro.) and (d) are amended to read:
- DOD 14.03 (4) (b) Grant and loan terms for grants and loans made under ss. s. DOD 14.04 and 14.05 shall be designed to maintain a development project fund. Grant and loan terms for recycling development project grants and loans made under s. DOD 14.055 shall be designed to maintain a recycling development project fund.
- 14.04 (3) (intro.) Before awarding a grant under this section, the <u>The</u> department shall consider each of the following: pars. (a) to (f) before awarding an early planning grant from the appropriation under s. 20.143 (fm), Stats., and pars. (a), (b) and (g) before awarding an early planning grant awarded under s. 560.835, (6) Stats.
- (d) The location of the proposed business in a development zone designated under s. 560.71, Stats. or a distressed an area that has high unemployment as defined in s.560.71 (1) (e) 1, Stats., or low per capita income as defined in s.560.71 (1) (e) 2, Stats., or both as defined in s. 560.14 (1) (d), Stats.
- SECTION 2. DOD 14.04 (3) (g) is created to read:
- DOD 14.04 (3) (g) The items contained under s. DOD 14.055 (4) (b) and (c).
- SECTION 3. DOD 14.04 (6) is repealed.
- SECTION 4. DOD 14.04 (7) and 14.055 (1), (2) (a) and (b), (3) and (4) (intro.) and (a) are amended to read:
- DOD 14.04 (7) Grants under this section may be awarded only to individuals who are minority group members and residents of this state eligible recipients as defined in s. 560.82 (5), Stats.
- 14.055 (1) An application by an eligible recipient, other than a diaper service, shall be considered only if it proposes to use postconsumer waste that is on the state priority list established pursuant to s. 159.03 (1) (b), Stats.

grant or loan under this section for a project under s. 560.835 (1) (a), (b) or (c), Stats., and shall consider pars par. (a) and (d) to (g) before awarding a loan or grant under this section for a project under s. 560.835 (1) (d), Stats.

SECTION 5. DOD 14.055 (4) (d) is repealed and recreated to read:

DOD 14.055 (4) (d) Whether the eligible applicant is conducting the project jointly with another entity and whether both entities share rights and responsibilities for completing the project.

SECTION 6. DOD 14.055 (4) (e) to (g) are repealed.

SECTION 7. DOD 14.055 (8) is amended to read:

DOD 14.055 (8) Awards under this section <u>for recycling development projects</u> may be used for capital expenses or working capital expenses.
