<u>ORDER</u>

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to amend Chir 2.11 (1) and (2) relating to reexamination fees.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2), 440.03 (2) and 440.06, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 440.06, Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order the Chiropractic Examining Board amends s. Chir 2.11 (2) as a result of rule-making by the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Clearinghouse Rule 93-113, effective December 1, 1993. In Clearinghouse Rule 93-113, the Department of Regulation and Licensing repealed and recreated s. RL 4.04 to reflect revisions to s. 440.05 (1), Stats., contained in 1993 Wisconsin Act 16. Listing of specific fees is removed from s. RL 4.04 and replaced by a rule which requires the department to maintain and make available to the public a list of current examination fees.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 2.11 (1) and (2) are amended to read:

- Chir 2.11 (1) STATE LAW EXAMINATION. An applicant who fails the state law examination shall be required to re-take retake that examination.
- (2) CLINICAL EXAMINATION. An applicant who fails the clinical examination due to the failure of one part of the examination may retake the failed part only. An applicant who fails the clinical examination due to the failure of 2 or more parts of the clinical examination shall be required to retake the entire clinical examination. The-fee-for-reexamination-shall-be-as specified-in-s--RL-4-04-(3).
