ORDER ADOPTING RULE

Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: ss. 114.20 and 227.11, Stats.

STATUTES INTERPRETED: s. 114.20, Stats.

General Summary of Rule. Chapter Trans 52, formerly AER 2, Display of Registration Certificate, was established in 1977 to provide a means of identifying aircraft registration status by physical inspection/observation for the current year decal. The Department discontinued issuing registration decals in 1982 when a more efficient computerized verification method was developed and implemented. Compliance with the requirements of s. 114.20(11), Stats., is still accomplished as the Department's computer-generated registration certificate must be retained ("displayed") inside the aircraft. Therefore, this rule making will repeal Chapter Trans 52.

During the transition period whereby the Revisor of Statutes is reformatting the Wisconsin Administrative Code to 8½" x 11" size, the Revisor has the authority under § 13.93(2m)(b)1, Stats., to renumber any provision of the Administrative Code. Accordingly, the Revisor chose to renumber AER 2 as Trans 52 in order to eliminate the AER book.

Fiscal Effect. None.

<u>Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis</u>. This rule will have no significant effect on small businesses.

TEXT OF RULE

Under the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, department of transportation, by ss. 114.20 and 227.11, Stats., the department of transportation hereby repeals a rule interpreting s. 114.20, Stats., relating to the display of registration certificate.

SECTION 1. Chapter Trans 52 is repealed.

Effective Date. This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.22(2), Stats.
